TYPES OF SURVEYS QLARANT PERFORMS



IN-PERSON SURVEY

- For adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) and their family members.
- Face-to-face or video conference.



FAMILY SURVEY

- For family members and/or legal guardians to complete.
- Mail the survey or enter online
- Three survey types: Adult Family Survey (AFS), Family Guardian Survey (FGS) and Child Family Survey (CFS).



STATE OF THE WORKFORCE SURVEY

- For provider agencies who render either services for IDD or aging and disability populations.
- Online survey collects comprehensive data to examine workforce challenges, identify areas for further investigation, and benchmark workforce data.
- Completed by provider agencies who report on wages, benefits, and turnover of the direct care professional workforce.



AGING AND DISABILITIES SURVEY

- Completed by aging or disability propulations.
- Conducted most commonly by telephone but can be done either face-to-face or by video.
